

TAX PAYER INFORMATION 12-2011

PAYMENT

- Please make check payable to LEE TOWNSHIP. We accept full or partial payments.
- Always include the Property ID to ensure accurate payment.
- Receipts will be mailed only if you include a self-addressed stamped envelope with payment.
- We accept postmarks for payment date.
- We do **NOT** accept credit or debit cards.
- If paying with cash, please have the **EXACT** amount. We do **NOT** have change available.
- Do not mail cash.

DELINQUENT TAXES

- Summer 2011 taxes are payable to Lee Twp Treasurer with a 1% per month interest from 09-15-2011 to 02-29-2012.
- All 2011 taxes are payable at County on 03-01-2012 as delinquent. (4% penalty & 1% per month penalty apply).
- Unpaid balance of taxes on 03-01-13 will result in forfeited property to County.
- Unpaid balance of taxes on 03-01-14 will result in additional fees and be subject to foreclosure by County.
- **State law prohibits reduction of penalties for failure to receive a tax bill and/or refund for payment of tax on the wrong parcel.**

TOWNSHIP TREASURER SCHEDULE

- My office at 1969 W Hines Rd will be open 9-6 on **Wednesdays only** from December 7 to February 29. (last day to pay taxes without penalty).
- If you are unable to make those office hours, please use my locked drop box.

ROADS

- Chip and seal is complete for: 7 mile (Chippewa to Olson); Olson (7 to 8 mile); 8 mile (Chippewa to M-20); 11 mile (Chippewa to M-20)

PARK

- The splash park is operational. It was built with \$200,000 in grant money. The hours of operation will be posted at the park when it opens again in summer.

WATER

- Grants and low interest loans are available for elderly and low income residents.
- The plumbing permit is available at the Township Code Authority as well as information about the curb box to house portion of the water system.
