BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The Board meets the second Monday at 7pm every month at our township hall. Our Board of Trustees reviewed the Private Road Agreements with many residents at the last meeting. Majority of residents on the three private roads in our township agreed to keep the Midland County Road Commission contracts for maintenance for the next two years. Some of the Board recently completed training on Open Meeting Act, Freedom of Information Act, ARPA funds, Legislative issues, bringing Broadband Internet through grants, Better Understanding Ordinances, Right to Farm Act,

PLANNING COMMISSION

The upcoming meeting for October 26th. Topics of discussion will be the possibility of Economy Efficient Dwellings (Tiny Homes); allowing more than one dwelling on a parcel, reduction of acreage and road frontage requirements; use of manufactured homes as dwellings; input from the community is always welcome. GRANT COMMITTEE

The Grant Committee meets twice a month (1st and 3rd Mon) until the end of the year. Searching out Grant funds available to OUR township. Survey update, surveys have been received and calculated. They have a strategic planning meeting coming for Grant ideas. Our Grant committee now has a Mission and Vision Statement. The Grant committee just submitted the first grant application for equipment for our Lee Twp Fire Department (LTFD), providing them with jaws of life, ram system and more. Looking for more Grant ideas for the PPE equipment for the volunteers. Stay tuned for more.



HALL NEWS

Hall recycling is a service provided with minimal cost to residents, included in the budget with curbside services on our winter property taxes. This service includes cardboard, plastics, paper, metal, and glass. We will also be adding a separate bin for deposit returnables for cans/bottles as a fundraiser for the Park.

ZONING ADMINISTRATION

Multiple Planning commission meetings have resulted in the development of three zoning ordinance supplement/amendment proposals approved by the Board of Trustees. The ordinances will simplify the permit process for both signs and dwellings. They will help ensure the introduction of solar farms will be handled in a responsible manner. The Zoning Administrator will be working on updating the zoning ordinances which are available online on the township website or at the township Hall.
