The board members are learning everyday. If we don't have the answer, we'll get the answers. Next month we will be looking at expenses and income and making sure the budget is within the guidelines. Roads were reviewed in OUR township and several roads will have improvements made next year.

## GRANT COMMITTEE

The Grant Committee meets twice a month (1st and 3rd Mon) until the end of the year. Searching out Grant funds available to OUR township. OUR FAMILY FUNDRAISING CARNIVAL is almost here. On December 12, 2022, the Township Board approved revisions to the Zoning Ordinance. The utilization of Economy Efficient Dwellings (Tiny Homes) in the Residential/Agriculture and Single-Family Residential Districts will be permitted as a Special Use. Also approved were reduction in the acreage requirements for dwelling construction in Residential/Agriculture and Single-Family Residential Districts from 1 acre to ½ acre along with a reduction of road frontage requirements from 132 feet to 75 feet. All of the above-mentioned ordinance revisions will go into effect on December 31, 2022. Additional information can be obtained from the Zoning

WINTER PROPERTY TAX BILLS WILL BE MAILED EARLY DECEMBER: Treasurer's office is open Mon-Fri 9am-3pm. Extended hours on Wednesday, December 28th 9am-5pm. Last day for winter property tax payments without penalty/interest is February 28th. Board of Review Dates to be posted soon.

Burning permits are required any time that snow is not covering the ground. Only brush, grass and leaves may be burned. Tires, furniture, plastic, building materials, household waste are only a few examples of items that are ILLEGAL to burn at any time.
