Lee Township Fire Department is looking for a few good men and women who like a challenge and wish to serve their community. We provide fire and rescue services to both Lee and Greendale Townships. If accepted into our department, you will be provided firefighter training, as well as medical first responder training. Initial training is arduous, and applicants must be in good physical condition as well as possessing good reading communications skills. Prior Military firefighter training or firefighter training from other states may qualify you. These are compensated on call positions with benefits, including pension and life insurance. PLANNING COMMISSION

On August 14, 2023, the Board of Trustees approved an amendment to the zoning ordinances which now permits the placement of mobile homes as single-family dwellings in Lee Township. The mobile home is required to comply with all codes and standards as deemed applicable by MC Twp Code Authority and must qualify for a certificate of occupancy or equivalent. The Board approved an amendment to the zoning ordinance which states, "One (1) single-family dwelling may be utilized as a dwelling per parcel unless the parcel is at least two (2) acres in which case a maximum of two (2) singlefamily dwellings may be on the parcel as dwellings. This provision does not apply if the structure at issue is part of an approved Planned Unit Development. The limitations set forth in this section also does not apply to temporary dwellings to the extent permitted in Chapter 7 and specifically Section 7.11."

TOWNSHIP NEWS:

- Hall rentals and Park pavilion rentals are on the rise. Check the calendar on our website, stop by the Hall for more information. Please remember at the Park, there are three pavilions, one is rented, the other two are only first come first serve. Looking into shade ideas and seating for the park.
- CEMETERY SEASON END CLEAN UP. Getting ready for winter, please check and finalize your end-of-season items and tidy up the area by October 31st. Then Winter items are cleaned up by April 1st.
- Cemetery news, help us keep the cemetery looking good. Watch over your decorative and sentimental items around your loved one's plots. Let's keep in mind the area is mowed and maintained, but some items extend over the area, and make it difficult to maintain. Lee Twp also makes the bases for the headstone, so make sure you call the hall to coordinate before headstones arrive.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

- Refuse & Recycle Center Cards are required at the Center for any services. Please make sure you have the card present to show at the Refuse & Recycle Center. One per household.
- If you have a Cemetery deed or any documents, stop by the hall, we would love to make a copy for our records here. If you have a plot, we can add the names, so it is recorded for future needs.
- Residents need to apply for Disabled Veterans Exemptions & Hardship Applications every year. These can be found on our Lee Twp Website or stop by the Hall for copies.
- Residents need to apply Homestead (PRE) Exemption after they purchase a home or after a deed, transfer of property or updating a Trust/LIFE lease (Recordable deed). You also need a Property Transfer Affidavit. These can be found on our Lee Twp website or pick up at the hall.
- Columbarium Niches are available for \$250 each and Cemetery Plots 5 for \$2,000 or 1 for \$500, contact the Clerk at Lee Twp Hall for more information.
- How much does it cost to rent the Hall? Our hall seats 200 people, with a choice of round tables or rectangle tables, has a full kitchen, double ovens, lots of supplies, and looks beautiful when decorated for a special event. Rental is \$200 and a deposit of \$50. Application and calendar are on our website.
- Can I rent one of the park pavilions? Yes, there is one for rent, which holds it for you for the day of your event for \$50. Two other pavilions are available on a first come first serve basis. Check the calendar for availability and apply online on our website.
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
